The Richmond Convention.

The Seceders from the Confederate Convention met at Richmond on the 11th, according to appointment. All of the seceding States were represented except Delaware. Mr. Fisher, the delegate of Charleston from the Seventh District of Virginia, took his seat in the Convention, and also two delegates from the Second District of Tennessee. Several gentlemen from New York appeared and were enrolled as delegates, but subsequently declined that position and explained that they merely came commissioners from some Democratic organization in New York city. They were then invited to take seats on the floor.

Ex-Governor Lubbock of Texas, was called to the Chair, and delivered a very indifferent address. Prayer was offered by the Rev. Dr. Barrows. Committees were appointed, and the Convention adjourned till Tuesday morning.

On Tuesday, after prayer by the Rev. Mr. Deacon, reports were made by the Committee on Organization and Credentials. The Hon. Joe Irvin, of Alabama, was nominated for President, with a long list of Vice Presidents and Secretaries. We happened to be present, and the body remained most of the day in session. When the officers had taken their seats on the platform, the floor was considerably thinned out. The Chairman, Mr. Lubbock, seemed very reluctant to give up his place. Instead of resigning at once to the President elect, he kept his seat and called for more delegates. Finally, a member moved that a Committee be appointed to conduct the President elect, the Governor, and the members of the convention twice—first by one of the Committee, and then by the Ex-Governor, who was reluctantly retired.

Mr. Irvin's address was chiefly characterized by the unusual deliberateness of its delivery. He spent most of the time in his feet in protracting the stage, apparently engaged in silent meditation. He, however, declared very distinctly and emphatically that the Convention was "strange the serpent of squalor now abiding."

A motion was next made to appoint a Committee on Business, but two resolutions were proposed as substitutes—the first declaring that as the delegates to the Convention had been appointed on the basis of the majority platform reported by the Committee at Charleston, it was unnecessary to take action on the subject at that time; and the second, that when the Convention adjourned it adjourn to meet in Richmond, on the 23d inst., unless the President should consider a proposition for its discontinuance. The resolution was carried. The English Admiral offered protection to American citizens.

Great agitation was produced in the Court of Naples on the reception of the news. The Ministers tendered their resignation on the 20th, and a liberal Cabinet was expected to succeed them.

Garibaldi had already instituted important administrative reforms at all places in his power.
