Letter From Harper's Ferry.

HARRIS FERRY, May 7.—The news of the capture of the Riley House by the Northern troops was received here yesterday. Several persons arrived from Washington, right from Baltimore. They give full account of the numbers of troops engaged, saying that there were not less than 1300. They say that the rebels were beaten at the Washington Junction, their carriage road open and their baggage largely scattered. It is a vigorous search. This is but a foretaste of the outrages upon private rights.

From all accounts the whole valley is up to arms. Dr. Dan. Conrad, son of Robert Y. Conrad, has been imprisoned in Massachusetts for refusing to take an oath of allegiance to the Federal Government. His father has gone North to see about it. If the Northern people persist in treating the citizens of the South in this way, they had better look to the security of their setts.


