Difficulty between the United States and Great Britain.

Occupancy of San Juan Island by Military Forces.

We have already noticed the difficulty existing on the Pacific coast, growing out of the dispute between the officers of the United States and Great Britain about the ownership of the San Juan.

A correspondent of the Victoria Gazette, writes to San Juan, gives the following interesting particulars of the movement of the American and English forces.

In order to ascertain the first movement applied to Mr. Hubbs, the United States Deputy Collector on the Island for the last three years or thereabouts, who kindly furnished me with such data as he had in his possession.

He has exercised the functions of a deputy collector on the island for near three years, and during that time has made regular quarterly returns of all imports and exports to and from the island to his government.

On Sunday H. M. S. Satellite and Plumper passed on their way to New Westminster for theappers and miners, intending to land them in joint occupation, the Plumber touching in the harbor, probably with despatches for the Tribune.

The interviews thus far between the respective officers have been characterized by that spirit of courtesy which belongs exclusively to the representatives of the greatest nations upon the earth, and although, so far, each think they are justified by right, no collision can occur, unless personal feeling of jealousy or hatred urges on to dishonorable war.

Continuing a northerly course for little more than a mile, a large deep and beautiful westerly indentation is presented, where the steady Tribune rides at anchor, with broadside commanding the shores.

Upon landing, we visited the little group of tents belonging to the Ninth United States Infantry, company D, Captain Geo. A. Pickett, where were three brass field pieces, to the wheel of the centre and larger of which was lashed a staff bearing a loft the United States flag.

The "Army" under Captain Pickett consists of sixty-six men, rank and file, including the Commissary Department, occupy twenty tents which, while there were being removed from the harbor frontage to a spot near the southern peninsula, is about a mile distant.

Yesterday morning a train of fourteen wagons arrived at Fort Leavenworth from Utah. Accompanying the train were fifteen of the children who escaped the terrible massacre at Mountain Meadows, in Utah some two years since.

There also came in with the train, under the special care of Sergeant Black, the three Foster children, of whom much has been in the papers. The father and mother lived in Connecticut. The father capou and left for Salt Lake City carrying with him his three little girls. The mother remained behind, and all efforts to retain her children were abortive.

On Wednesday the annexed protest against the occupation of San Juan was issued and publicly posted at the door of the Tribune. We presume it is done so in a more orderly form, like the order to Captain Pickett, for documents on neither side can be of much value.

Interesting from Washington.

There is no truth in the recent statement from Vera Cruz that Minister McLane had presented an ultimatum and demanded the immediate ratification of the treaty, for it is known here that the preliminary points thereof were mutually satisfactory to both the Government and that of the Constitutionalist.

Gen. Harney has acquiesced in the General's occupation of the Island of San Juan. It appears that he had not been previously specifically instructed to take possession, but had seen troops thither to protect the treaty or ability of the British Commission, who had been included in the treaty, and was the author of the occupation of the Island.

A letter from Gen. Vidaurt, just received, speaks in confident terms of the prospects of the Constitutionalist. He was employed in sending troops into the interior of Mexico from Monterey. Arms and munitions of war were several days ago sent him from one of the Northern ports of our country.

Important from Washington. Mr. McLane has arrived at Mobile from Vera Cruz with the annexed protest against the constitutional government there, under the recent instructions sent out to him. He is expected to arrive here on Thursday night.

This treaty secures to us a perpetual transit over the Tehuantepec isthmus, which was a great point when the treaty of peace was made with Mexico, and for which millions would have been paid there, and in addition, it secures to the silver producing district of Arizona a free route and port on the Gulf of California, which is all important to it for supplies and under existing circumstances.
