SLAVE LABOR IN CHALESTON.

The Editor of the Home (New York) Scatified, in a letter to his paper from Charleston, given the following impressions of the system of slavery as artibited in the condition of the slaves in that eity;

The city of Charleston has a population of some 60,000 inhabitants; what proportion of the shore is colored I have not the means at hand to accurately desermine; but judging from the number that is met dily in the streen, I should say that at least 40,000 of the 60,000 are of the black race. The most of the colored population, though not all, are slave. I learn that a number at effect, and own slaves themselves. This may seem strange to many Northern people—suppendily to that ohen who cannot understand or appreciate that system of labor knews as slave labor, in other words, owing the services of another instead of hiring them.

I have seen nothing of alavery as is exist upon the plantations; and but listile of course as it prevails in the city; but from my observations whilst here, I am more fully confirmed in previous belief, that the free States fall entirely to understand the system, as well as the views and feelings of the slaves themselves.
