The Confederate States and Foreign Nations.

The commissioners from the Confederate States appointed to proceed to Europe to obtain the recognition of the new Republic from England, France, Belgium, &c. are on their way to discharge that duty.

It is not probable that the European power will recognize the Southern Confederacy immediately, but will await evidence of its permanency. But as soon as it is ascertained that a de facto Government exists at the South, foreign nations may recognize and establish commercial relations with it...

Thus every State in Europe except Austria recognized the new State of the United Netherlands during the long interval of seventy years which preceded their recognition by Spain.

The formal recognition of the South American Republic by Great Britain took place in 1825, and under the negotiation of a treaty of commerce, while they were yet unacknowledged by the mother country.

During the late Executive session of the Senate, about four hundred nominations were confirmed, nearly fifty of which were sent in by the President yesterday.
