PROCLAMATION OF MAJ. GENERAL BANKS.

ARMED OF COL. GEORGE F. MAYER.

(From the Daily American of Friday.) At about three o'clock yesterday morning a military force, consisting of several companies of the Maryland and Pennsylvania troops, proceeded to the residence of Col. George F. Mayer, Marshal of Police of the city of Baltimore, on St. Paul street, near Madison, and remained there until the forces with their horses and equipments from General Banks for his immediate arrest and conveyance to Fort McHenry.

A skirmish was in attendance and the Marshal was placed therein and conveyed directly to Fort McHenry, where he is now held to await the action of the Government in connection with the charges against him. At 10 o'clock in the morning Colonel John J. Kelly, of the Penn. Maryland Regiment, in camp at Morris' Grove, reported to the office of Major Tracy, accompanied by L. S. Tarr, Esq., of the same command, having exhibited to the Major his appointment by General Banks to proceed Marshal of the city of Baltimore, and his right to take command of the Police Department of the city. The Major immediately accompanied him to the office of the Police Commissioners, and after a short interview Col. Kelly presented his commission to Marshal Tracy and told him that he had come to the office in accordance with his instructions.

It is understood that the Commissioners of police declined to recognize the authority of General Tracy, Major Tracy, shortly suspending their office.
